## FROM THE DESK OF REV. ALICIA BURTON

"We the undersigned having been baptized into Christ, desire to form a congregation of the Christian Church Disciples of Christ. The congregation shall be called CENTRAL CHRISTIAN CHURCH. We do this that we may unite our means and influence to advance the Kingdom of our Lord, in our own lives and in the world at large.

We declare that we have taken God to be our Father, Jesus Christ to be our Savior, the Holy Spirit to be our Guest and Guide, the Word of God to be our rule of faith and practice.

Pledging loyalty to our Lord, and fidelity to each other, we hereunto affix our names."

Thus begins the covenant that united First Christian Church and Dozier Christian Church January 7, 1968. 126 persons signed the covenant on that day. Since we are almost to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this union, I thought we should have some sort of celebration. I invite each one of you to write down a memory or anecdote to be compiled into a booklet for the anniversary. Some of you might want to think of a goal or hope for the future of the congregation. Perhaps you would like to write a prayer for the future. Let the Spirit be your guide as is stated in the covenant. Please have these ready by December 10 to allow time for the booklet to be completed.
